You don't have to perform good works or religious deeds in order to gain His love and acceptance. Neither do you have to make peace with God to obtain salvation because Jesus already has; "For he is our peace... that he might reconcile [you] to God" (Eph. 2:14; 16). Jesus' love never fails!

If you believe that Christ's death was sacrificial and substitutional on your behalf, then you are ready to become the royally adopted child of God. The costly price for your personal adoption has already been paid—the precious blood of Jesus. All you have to do now is pray to Him with a humble attitude of trusting faith and heart-felt repentance. Jesus has surely promised you, "All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out" (Jn. 6:37).

Dear Lord Jesus, I am sorry for all my sins. Because I believe that You lovingly died for my sins, I now ask You to forgive me for all my sins (past, present, and future) and to cleanse those sins and their accompanying guilt from me. Adopt me now into Your heavenly family and make me a new creature by giving me Your indwelling Spirit. Thank you, Lord. Amen.



The world's best kept secret is found in an ancient Near East document whose first compiled volume of five books was written around 1500 BC. Many other volumes were added to this collection of books until coming into its completed canonical form of Old and New Sections around 100 AD. Today, this document is known as the Bible.
