The delay of this flight cost Singapore Airlines \$100,000. That was a great price to pay for a "passenger" with no ticket! The airport authorities had every right to detain the aircraft because there was a potential danger or harm to the populace. With this illustration in mind, let us look to a Biblical perspective of what God thinks of the "virus of sin".

God (like the airport authority) shuts the door of heaven's gate and absolutely does not allow anything unclean to enter therein. Why should He? He is holy and His dwelling is holy, and He intends on keeping it that way! The Bible says, "And there shall in no wise enter into it [Heaven] any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but [only] they which are written in the Lamb's book of life." (Rev. 21:27)

Going to heaven is not a question of being good enough, as the Bible has already cleared up this issue when it declares, "there is none that doeth good, no, not one." (Rom. 3:12) The simple fact is, you do not have to be good to get into heaven – you must be perfect! That means you must be

(Rev. 21:8)

punished for those sins on the cross. Therefore, the "virus of sin" is no longer a threat to anyone who sees that Jesus died under its penalty so that we might be safe and free from its eternal harm.

totally free from sin. You are probably saying right now, "This is impossible!", and you are right. Before we look at how to be free from sin, let us look at the problem of sin, the dreaded "virus"...

The Bible says, "the soul that sinneth, it shall die." (Ezekiel 18:4) Sin is like a virus: First we become infected, slowly developing a high fever (intense lustings over various things that are out of the will of God), and then we die! The Bible confirms this, "Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death." (James 1:15). But God, the ultimate Authority, desiring to keep us safe for all eternity, allowed His Son to take upon Himself this "virus of sin" so that it could be contained once and for all.

So to be perfect, (completely free from the "virus of sin"), simply let the Royal red blood of Jesus that He shed for you on the cross of Calvary wash all your sins away. "*Unto him* [Jesus] *that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,*" (Rev. 1:5). Jesus, the "perfect man" (the Godman), traded places with less than perfect people and took their sins upon Him and was
